Our purpose is to create a boy's ranch ... so, when is it going to happen?

Creating a boy's ranch is Walk Reclaimed's reason for being, but it is taking some time. We have been planning the infrastructure, making connections with state and local officials, and getting training. All of that takes time, but we are making progress. The biggest thing determining our schedule is the land, and we are still a long way from our funding goal.

What are we doing now?

Until we are able to establish the ranch and start providing a home for these boys we have begun working with other organizations to provide mentorship to youth, especially boys with a history of sex trafficking or other abuse.

What Are We About?

Walk Reclaimed is a tax exempt charity organization (501c3) whose purpose is to provide a home for boys who have been victimized by sex trafficking.

Girls are not the only victims, thousands of boys are trapped in this horror too and currently there are no homes to meet their long term needs. We plan to buy land and create a boy's ranch to provide these children with a safe place to live, grow and learn. A place to have the childhood that was taken

from them.

What Have We Been Doing?

Earlier in the summer I spent a month in Eastern Oregon where we hope to locate the ranch. I spoke in churches, met with civic leaders, and discussed needs and requirements with government officials. We have begun creating the plans, policies and procedures that will be needed.

We are also working with another organization in California to provide mentorship to boys.

An Acre of Hope

Our biggest hurdle is the money. We will continue with the preparations but we have to secure the property before the ranch can become a reality, and that will take money.

We have launched a fund raising campaign called An Acre of Hope. This is a peer to peer campaign allowing you to contribute directly but also to create your own campaign and share it with your contacts.
